### Liturgical Calendar

Mon 9 Oct: St Denis and Companions, he was sent from Rom in 250 AD to preach to the Gauls and was the first Bishop of Paris. He and two other Christians were tortured and beheaded by the Roman governor Wed 11 Oct: St John XXIII (1881-1963), born into a peasant family, ordained in 1904 and a war chaplain in WWI. Elected Pope in 1958, and soon convened the Second Vatican Council but died during the Council. Thurs 12 Oct: St Kenneth, was born and died in Ireland however, he spent time with St Cadoc in Wales and St Columba in Iona. He founded a monastery in St Andrews. The ruined Abbey of Cambuskenneth still bears his name. He died in 599.

Sat 14 Oct: St Callistus, who after a life of slavery and imprisonment for crimes alleged by bitter opponents, became a deacon and then Pope from 218 to 222. Martyred.
