Having 'quality time' with God, to pray, reflect and renew our energy is central. Jesus gives us an excellent example here by going away to a deserted place to pray. Let us remember to stay close to the source of all love.

Liturgical Calendar

Mon 5 Feb: Saint Agatha (231-251) lived in Sicily. Aged 15 she resisted the amorous advances of a public official who became a judge and who sent her to prison where she died from her tortures.

Tues 6 Feb: St Paul Miki and Companions (1565-1597). He and twenty-six fellow martyrs were crucified at Nagasaki. When missionaries came back to Nagasaki in 1860, they discovered thousands of Catholics to whom the Faith had been handed down over 250 years.

Thurs 8 Aug: St Josephine Bakhita (1868-1947) kidnapped from her village in Darfur (Sudan), bought and sold several times over twelve years, then given to an Italian diplomate who took her to Italy under the care of the Canossian Sisters. It is said her prayers saved the village from aerial bombardment during WWII.
