Blessed Carlo Acutis To Be Canonised A Saint

The Vatican's Dicastery for Saints announced a second miracle is recognised. The young layman was born May 3 1991 in London and died in Monza, Italy on 12 Oct 2006, succumbing to leukemia at the age of 15.

The miracle related to a woman from Costa Rica, who had prayed and left a letter at Blessed Carlo's tomb in Assisi. Six days previously her daughter had fallen off her bicycle and suffered severe head trauma requiring craniotomy surgery to reduce pressure on the brain, with a very low chance of survival. The mother's secretary began praying immediately to Blessed Carlo and the mother went to Assisi to pray. That same day the hospital reported that the daughter had begun to breathe spontaneously, the next day move and partially regain her speech. Ten days later a scan proved that the haemorrhage had disappeared. The following month both mother and daughter went to Assisi and thanked Blessed Carlo for his intercession. Source: Vatican News

Mon 20 May: St Augustine of

Canterbury (+605) was sent by Pope St Gregory the Great in 595 to evangelise Kent and to organise the Church already existing in large parts of England. He was the first Archbishop of Canterbury. Known as the 'Apostle to the English'.

<u>Wed 29 May:</u> St Paul VI was elected pope in 1963 and oversaw much of the second Vatican Council which had been opened by Pope St. John XXIII.

Fri 31 May: The Visitation of The Blessed

Virgin Mary – Feast commemorating the meeting between Pary and her cousin Elizabeth at Ein Kerem, juts outside Jerusalem. Feeling the presence of his Divine Saviour, John leapt in his mother's womb on Mary's arrival. Following Elizabeth's words of greeting, Mary proclaimed the Magnificat, a hymn praising God for all that he had done for his handmaid and expressing her attitude of faith and humility.
