### Liturgical Calendar

**Mon 15 July:** Memorial of **Saint Bonaventure** (1221-74) was baptised John. St Francis of Assisi was credited with curing him from a serious illness while still a child and so his mother nicknamed him “Buona Ventura”. He joined the Franciscans and at 35 was elected Superior of the Franciscans. He provided them with a good structure for running their affairs and a clear spirituality based on the sayings of St Francis. He wrote many works on philosophy and theology, intertwining the two. Among theologians he is called the Seraphic Doctor.

**Tues 16 July:** *Opt. Mem.* of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**, a name accorded to Our Lady by the 12c. hermits who used Mount Carmel near Haifa, Israel. This was the beginning of the Carmelite Order
