Numbers of Catholics attending Mass on the rise: There has been a big increase in Mass attendance recorded in Britain. Data shows that 95,029 people attended Sunday Mass in Scotland in 2023, compared to 89,420 the previous year. In England and Wales, the latest figures from the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales reveal that, while 503,308 attended Mass in 2022, 554,913 did so in 2023.

**St Teresa of Calcutta:** Pope Francis decided to place the liturgical memory of Mother Teresa of Calcutta in the official liturgical calendar of the entire Catholic Church. This means that Catholics around the world will now have the option to celebrate her memory in the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours every year on September 5<sup>th</sup> - the day of her passing in 1997.

Born Anjeze Gonxhe Bojaxhiu in 1910 in what is now North Macedonia, Mother Teresa left home as a teenager to join the Sisters of Loreto in Ireland before beginning her work in India. There, she heard what she described as a 'call within a call' - a divine summons to serve 'the poorest of the poor.' She left her convent, walked the streets of Calcutta, and devoted herself to the dying, the abandoned, and the destitute. In 1950, she founded the Missionaries of Charity, which continues to serve the marginalized in over 130 countries.

The decree introducing her liturgical memorial highlights the profound impact of her work. It describes her as a "tireless worker of charity" who restored dignity to those the world had discarded. It also recalls Christ's words from the Gospel of Mark: "Whoever wants to be great among you must be your servant." These words, the document notes, encapsulate Mother Teresa's entire life.

By adding her to the General Roman Calendar, the Church is not just honouring a saint - it is inviting the faithful to reflect on a radical call to love and to follow her example of humility and service. *Source: Zenit.org*
