Monday 16 June Feast of All Saints of Scotland

This new feast recalls the many local Saints throughout Scotland's Christian history, whose number is too great to be commemorated individually.

However, if you would like to read about the history of Catholicism in the Highlands, there is an excellent book *The Catholic Highlands of Scotland* available to read for free on-line. Written by the monk and historian **Dom. Odo Blundell, OSB** (1868-1943), the book covers Strathbogie (Huntly), Glenlivet, Strathavon, Glencairn, Braemar, Badenoch, Lochaber and finally Strathglass.

Published in 1909, Volume 1 covers the Highlands, while volume II covers the Western Highlands and the Islands. In your browser, go to the website Archive.org and search for 'The Catholic Highlands of Scotland', then select volume 1 with its dark navy blue cover, you can tap or click on a page to turn the page or use the slider to delve further into the book.

DEANERY PILGRIMAGE to St Mary's Beaulieu

Bishop Hugh Gilbert, OSB, will lead a Deanery Pilgrimage to St Mary's Beaulieu in **early September 2025**.

The liturgy will be organised by Father Max and Father James, but at some stage as in 2016, the clergy, pilgrims and parishioners having finished a short service in the church, may form an orderly procession and walk to the 'venerable ruins' of Beaulieu Priory, singing a hymn or two.

That pilgrimage was well attended with food and refreshments supplied from a large tent in the church orchard. The tent was generously supplied by the Fraser men of Strathglass.

To prepare for September we need to form a team of volunteers. An essential task is to obtain the necessary permissions from Historic Environment Scotland (formerly Historic Scotland) and Police Scotland. This is not an onerous job but both bodies need to grant permission. The need for a large tent must be investigated as does catering for the pilgrims.

Please consider this appeal and think what you could offer in way of enthusiasm, energy, know-how / skills. Large cloth banners would be an excellent addition to any procession, one for St Mary's Beaulieu, and one with the logo for the Jubilee Year 2025.

If you are interested, even tentatively at this stage, please try and meet up with others after Mass, at the back of the church or over a cuppa in the parish room.
