Monday 9th June Feast of St Columba, Abbot, who was born of royal blood in Gartan, county Donegal. In the year 563 he left for Iona where he founded a monastery from which the Faith was preached in the Highlands and Islands of Scotland. He died in 597 and was buried on Iona.

Monday 16 June Feast of All Saints of Scotland

This is a new feast in our liturgical calendar and recalls the many local Saints throughout Scotland's Christian history, whose number is too great to be commemorated individually. The Feast of All Saints of Scotland was added to the Liturgical Calendar for Scotland after approval by the Bishops of Scotland, by the Dicastery of Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in 2024.

New Beaulieu Primary School
