Vatican Backs Debt Reform The Vatican has endorsed a report calling for reforms to alleviate the global debt crisis affecting billions of people in developing countries – one of the main initiatives of the 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope. Whilst 32 countries in Africa spend more on debt repayments than on healthcare, a Bill is going through Westminster that could lead to millions of pounds worth of debts being cancelled in lower-income countries. 90% of lower-income country debts owed to private lenders are overseen by UK law. This new law, if passed, could make the debt relief process faster and fairer. ICE raids: 'It is not of the Gospel of Jesus Christ' After US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents entered Church properties in California, Bishop Rojas, who heads the sixth-largest Catholic diocese in the United States, strongly condemned the ramping up of ICE activities: "It is not of the Gospel of Jesus Christ - which guides us in all that we do." The bishop called on all political leaders to "reconsider and cease these tactics immediately" and replace them "in favour of an approach that respects human rights and human dignity." These changes can help build "a more lasting, comprehensive reform of our immigration system."

Peter's Pence 2024 report shows increase in support for Pope's mission
The 2024 report on Peter's Pence just released shows an increase in donations supporting the Pope's mission. The annual fund brings in donations for the Pope's mission for the universal Church. It raised €58 million in 2024, an increase from €52 million in 2023. A total of €13.3 million funded 239 direct assistance projects in 66 countries around the world.
