**The Margaret Sinclair Story: Thursday 24 July at 7.30 pm, in St. Columba's**

**Culloden** - marking 100 years since the death of Venerable Margaret Sinclair, AGAP – a Catholic professional theatre company based in the Archdiocese of Glasgow – is offering a preview performance, before taking it to the Edinburgh Fringe Festival.
