### Volunteers Needed: Help Us Build Our Lady's Grotto

As part of our preparations for the upcoming *Deanery Pilgrimage* on **Saturday, 13th September**, we are inviting parishioners to volunteer their time and skills to help build **Our Lady's Grotto** in the parish garden.

If you are willing to help with gardening or general assistance, please speak to the priests / Donald Shaw / Clare Gray / Donald Bolger / Carol Hooper. All hands are welcome! Let us honour Our Lady with love and dedication and work together as a parish family to make this grotto a reality.

**Saints Martha, Mary & Lazarus:** These three siblings lived in Bethany, just outside Jerusalem and were friends of Jesus. On one visit, Jesus had Mary sitting at his feet and listening to him when Martha complained that she was not helping her prepare the meal. Jesus chided Martha, telling her that her sister "had chosen the good portion." Later we hear the graphic account of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead to the delight of the two sisters. Pope Francis declared in 2021 the siblings should share the same Feast Day.

**St Ignatius of Loyola:** (1491-1556) was born in the Basque country. He became a soldier and was seriously injured in a battle (Pamplona, 1521). During his long recuperation he received the grace of spiritual conversion. He read about the lives of Christ and the saints and realised their worth, compared to the lives of so many people like himself. Later, at the University of Paris, he and five fellow students took religious vows (the first step in founding the Society of Jesus). In Rome, Ignatius led the new order and it became a key element in the Counter Reformation. The Jesuits remain prominent in the education of the young, in foreign missions, in charitable works and in scholarships. Pope Francis was the first Jesuit Pope.

**St Alphonsus Liguori:** (1696-1787) was born near Naples and was talented in music, art and poetry; his first choice of career was law but, aged 27, he decided to be a priest. He worked among the homeless youth in Naples and in nearby rural areas; he became known as a preacher with a simple and direct style and as a confessor who, although opposing moral laxity, rejected rigorist attitudes, such as the heresy of Jansenism. In 1732 he founded the Redemptorist Order and in 1762 he was made a bishop. He had a special devotion to Mary, particularly under the title of "Our Lady of Perpetual Succour." Due to ill health and difficulties for his active work, he resigned from his diocese and returned to private life in his order.
