### Apple Crumble Anyone?

This is the Season of Creation, an ecumenical celebration of prayer and action for the care of the Earth which runs from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi. Clare Gray, a member of the Justice & Peace Group writes:

“To celebrate the day's events on 13<sup>th</sup> September, I am offering to make apple crumbles with the children of the parish and we will give some as gifts to the pilgrims on the 13<sup>th</sup> Sept. The plan is for the children to come to the orchard and pick some apples and plums on the afternoon of Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September. We will stew them, make crumble topping.

However, I am very conscious of hygiene so Teresa Palmer, Jill Kent and myself are going to make about 30 finished crumbles on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>. Older children and adults can prepare the fruit on the Friday afternoon. The children will make some crumble topping, but I will have a batch to use for the ones we are giving as gifts. The children can take their own prepared food home with them if they want to.

It would be good if some children were able to give the gifts to the pilgrims as they come into the church on Saturday.”
