



St Joseph's (Highland) Deanery Pilgrimage Beauly 13 September 2025



St Mary's Roman Catholic Church in Beauly, founded in 1864 and built in the Gothic Revival style, stands as a testament to the resilience of the Catholic faith in the Highlands. Dedicated to the Virgin Mary, it carries a rich heritage linking it to Beauly Priory, founded in 1230 by Valliscaulian monks whose contemplative life shaped the region's spirituality. Designated as a pilgrim church for the Jubilee Year 2025, proclaimed by Pope Francis, St Mary's invites the faithful to grace, reconciliation and renewal. As we gather for our deanery pilgrimage, we are called to reflect on these deep roots of faith and draw inspiration from this "beautiful place" where history and devotion meet.
