**Advent:** Next Sunday is the **First Sunday of Advent – Year A**. A new season begins. Advent. So does a new liturgical Year, and since it is Year A, so does the three year liturgical cycle. **Calls have been made to reject extreme abortion up to birth plans:**

A [review of abortion law](#) in Scotland commissioned by the Scottish Government, and undertaken by a group chaired by a [former trustee](#) of the UK's largest abortion provider, has recommended that Scotland scrap the 24-week time limit and allow abortions on social grounds, including for sex-selective purposes, right up to birth..

If this proposed change becomes law, Scotland would have one of the most extreme abortion laws in the world, and a different time limit to that of England and Wales, where it will remain at 24 weeks, and many EU countries, where the most common abortion time limit among EU countries is [12 weeks](#).

Gerry Maguiness completes his second term of office. She will be the first member of the lay faithful and first woman to take on the role of General Secretary.

After gaining Master's degrees in both Engineering and Business Administration, she worked for almost forty years in industry, ultimately as chief executive of a Scottish business which she led for over two decades.

Luisa grew up in the diocese of Galloway and has lived in both the archdiocese of Glasgow and the diocese of Aberdeen. Her work has taken her to every diocese in Scotland.
