### The Month of Mary

Pope Leo has urged Catholics across the globe to pray to Our Lady for peace during the upcoming Marian month of May and he has shown the way by holding two special Rosary vigils reminding people of the power and the beauty of the Rosary as a means of prayer. At a solemn vigil in St Peter's Basilica, he said: "My dearest friends, all it takes is a little faith, a mere "crumb" of faith, in order to face this dramatic hour in history together - as humanity and alongside humanity... "Let us rise from the rubble! Nothing can confine us to a predetermined fate, not even in this world where there never seem to be enough graves, for people continue to crucify one another and eliminate life, with no regard to justice and mercy."
