Venezuelan priest: Some places unrecognizable after earthquakes

In the wake of Pope Leo XIV's prayers for the people of Venezuela struck by a succession of deadly earthquakes last week, a 4.6-magnitude aftershock hit north of the capital, Caracas, early on Monday, while rescue teams continued their fourth day of round-the-clock work in the hope of finding survivors.

Father Vázquez, Rector of the Seminary, explained that "people are still being rescued. For example, just last night, near our seminary, a 12-year-old boy was pulled alive from the rubble, even though the earthquake occurred last Wednesday night. We are here to help and to accompany the people. There has been a great deal of solidarity. We have seen it both in the rescue teams that have arrived from other places and in the strength and resilience of the Venezuelan people," Father Vázquez said. He also lamented that many members of the parish **Caritas** organizations of the local Church had either died or remain missing. The Seminary building was destroyed. *Source Vatican*
