A new statue of the Virgin Mary has been consecrated in Poland

The 55.6-metre (182ft) concrete figure is roughly two double-decker buses longer than Rio de Janeiro's smaller Christ the Redeemer monument. The statue in rural Konotopie was consecrated by the local bishop in a ceremony on Saturday, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
