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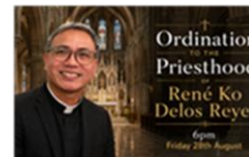

Pope Leo's Message for the 10th World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation:

The Church observes the World Day on September 1st with this year's theme being, "They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks" (Isaiah 2:4). "The true tools for building peace," Pope Leo underscored, "are not weapons of destruction; instead, they are truth, dialogue, patience, goodness, justice, mercy, understanding, care and love," which he said flow from hearts shaped by the Gospel and sustained by God's grace.
